Taglines:

Voiceover (1950s Toff style): Meet Tom (*he waves*)

And Henry (*he waves*)

They are best friends (*they shake hands enthusiastically, then pretend to share a joke*)

They'd been friends at primary school, secondary school *and* sixth form. They even attended ballet classes together (*they both look embarrassed*)

Such was the level of their friendship, they decided to move into a house together at university (*they mime opening a door and stepping over the threshold*)

Things started off great in their new home (*they puts their thumbs up*)

They would cook together (*mime eating and then rubbing stomachs*), tidy up together (*one mimes hovering whilst the other mimes ironing*) but most importantly they would laugh together (*mime OTT laughter*)

Life couldn't get much better

Yet before long, the cracks began to show (*they sit with arms folded and backs turned on each other*)

Neither of them was solely to blame (*they point an accusing finger at one another*)

Every time Tom forgot to wash the dishes (*Henry looks indignant*), Henry left the landing light on (*Tom now looks indignant*)

Henry's frustration at Tom's habit of speaking with his mouth full was only matched by his own tendency to talk loudly on his mobile telephone (*possible actions*)

Things came to a head when Tom realised that Henry had used the last of Tom's toothpaste (*Henry brushes his teeth joyfully, whilst Tom stares at an empty tube*)
